

Range re-opening

The opening of the range requires that everyone follow the social distancing guidelines outlined by the Governor. We are implementing the following policy to ensure a safe experience for everyone using the range and these rules will remain in effect until such time as they are no longer needed..

When entering the club, everyone must wash or sterilize their hands. Guests must also complete the Liability Waiver form. The range exhaust fan must remain on during your entire visit to assure positive air flow down range. Upon leaving and after normal clean up, spray each booth used with the provided disinfectant spray before exiting the range area and wash or sterilize your hands before leaving the club.

If the range is in use when you arrive, you must wait outside the area in order to maintain social distancing. Once a shooting session has begun it cannot be joined by a new group. Use of the range is on a first-come, first-served basis. Waiting can be done in the club house as long as social distancing is maintained. If there are others already waiting in the club house, you may have to come back at another time. We expect some delays during the initial re-opening period. Please be patient. Additional signage will be added to reinforce these rules! Safety First.

In Summary:

- Maintain social distancing.**
- Wash or sterilize your hands on arrival.**
- Guests must complete the Waiver Liability form.**
- Ensure the range exhaust fan is kept running during your entire shooting session!**
- After the usual clean up (shell casings, etc), apply spray disinfectant in each booth used (hand wheel for targets, broom handles, areas touched, etc)**
- Wash or sterilize your hands upon leaving**
